ESV	It is not the old who are wise, nor the aged who understand what is right.
NIV	It is not only the old who are wise, not only the aged who understand what is right.
NLT	Sometimes the elders are not wise. Sometimes the aged do not understand justice.

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. σοφοί οὐδ αὐτοὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὐδέ greek Meaning * Not * Nor * Neither * Not even A combination of the words οὐ (meaning no) and δέ (meaning however or but). The word οὐδέ adds another negative element to a sentence that already has one. οὐδέ can join words, phrases, or whole clauses.
