NLT	But if not, then listen to me. Keep silent and I will teach you wisdom!”
LXX	εἰ μὴ σὺ ἄκουσόν μου κώφευσσον καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” διδάξω σε σοφίαν
KJV	If not, hearken unto me: hold thy peace, and I shall teach thee wisdom.

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
