ESV	so that they caused the cry of the poor to come to him, and he heard the cry of the afflicted-
NIV	They caused the cry of the poor to come before him, so that he heard the cry of the needy.
NLT	They cause the poor to cry out, catching God's attention. He hears the cries of the needy.

IT is most frequently translated as "and" κραυγὴν πτωχῶν εἰσακούσεται
KJV	So that they cause the cry of the poor to come unto him, and he heareth the cry of the afflicted.
