The word is dual in form (ending in -ים) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalm 115:3 וְרָאָה וְשׂוֹר שְׁחָקִים גְּבוּהוּ מִמֶּנָּה

Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 καὶ οὐρανὸν καὶ γῆν greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἰδέ κατὰ μαθε δὲ οὐρανὸν καὶ γῆν greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. νύμφη ὡς ὑψηλὰ ἀπὸ σοῦ
