LXX	<p>ἐπεὶ δὲ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. οὖν δίκαιος εἶ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>εἶμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</p> <p>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. τί δώσεις αὐτῷ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same</p> <p>Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.</p> <p>Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)</p> <p>ἢ τί ἐκ χειρός σου λήμψεται</p>
