IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀπὸ πνοῆς ἰσχυροῦ δώσει πάγος οἰακίζει δέ δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. τὸ greek The definite article ὕδωρ ὡς ἐὰν βούληται
