ESV	After it his voice roars; he thunders with his majestic voice, and he does not restrain the lightnings when his voice is heard.
NIV	After that comes the sound of his roar; he thunders with his majestic voice. When his voice resounds, he holds nothing back.
NLT	Then comes the roaring of the thunder- the tremendous voice of his majesty. He does not restrain it when he speaks.
