Hebrew	כָּאֵבֹן מִיֵּם יִתְחַבְּאוּ וּפְנֵי תְהוֹם יִתְלַפְּדוּ
ESV	The waters become hard like stone, and the face of the deep is frozen.
NIV	when the waters become hard as stone, when the surface of the deep is frozen?
NLT	For the water turns to ice as hard as rock, and the surface of the water freezes.
LXX	ἢ καταβαίνει ὥσπερ ὕδωρ ῥέον πρόσωπον δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἀβύσσου τίς ἔπηξεν
KJV	The waters are hid as with a stone, and the face of the deep is frozen.
