Hebrew	יִחַרְרוּ בְעֵמֶק וַיִּשְׂשִׂי בְכַח לְצֹא לְקִרְאֵת נַשֵּׁק
ESV	He paws in the valley and exults in his strength; he goes out to meet the weapons.
NIV	He paws fiercely, rejoicing in his strength, and charges into the fray.
NLT	It paws the earth and rejoices in its strength when it charges out to battle.
LXX	<p>ἀνορούσων ἐν</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Preposition meaning “in”. πεδίω γαυριᾶ ἔκπορεύεται δὲ</p> <p>δέ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. εἰς πεδίον ἐν</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Preposition meaning “in”. ἰσχύι</p>
KJV	He paweth in the valley, and rejoiceth in his strength: he goeth on to meet the armed men.
