Hebrew	פָּנִים hebrew Meaning: * Face * Presence * Front or surface Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. תָּרַב
	ESV He laughs at fear and is not dismayed; he does not turn back from the sword.
	NIV He laughs at fear, afraid of nothing; he does not shy away from the sword.
	NLT It laughs at fear and is unafraid. It does not run from the sword.
LXX	συναντῶν βέλει καταγελᾷ καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" οὐ μὴ ἀποστραφῇ ἀπὸ σιδήρου
	KJV He mocketh at fear, and is not affrighted; neither turneth he back from the sword.

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
