NIV	"If someone ventures a word with you, will you be impatient? But who can keep from speaking?
NLT	"Will you be patient and let me say a word? For who could keep from speaking out?
LXX	<p>μη̅ πολλὰκις σοι λελάληται ἐν̅ greek</p> <p>Preposition meaning "in". κόπῳ ἰσχυ̅ν δέ̅ greek</p> <p>δέ̅ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ῥημάτων σου τίς ὑποίσει</p>
KJV	If we assay to commune with thee, wilt thou be grieved? but who can withhold himself from speaking?
