ESV	Have you an arm like God, and can you thunder with a voice like his?
NIV	Do you have an arm like God's, and can your voice thunder like his?
NLT	Are you as strong as God? Can you thunder with a voice like his?
	ἢ βραχίων σοί ἐστὶν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. κατὰ τοῦ greek Meaning: * The LXX The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ κυρίου ἡ φωνῇ κατ' αὐτὸν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) βροντᾷς
