Hebrew	יִחַשֵׁב לְתַבּוֹ בְּרֹגַל לַעֲץ רֶקֶבִיו נְחֹשֶׁה
ESV	Out of his mouth go flaming torches; sparks of fire leap forth.
NIV	Firebrands stream from his mouth; sparks of fire shoot out.
NLT	Lightning leaps from its mouth; flames of fire flash out.
LXX	ἐκ στόματος αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἐκπορεύονται λαμπάδες καιόμεναι καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" διαρριπτοῦνται ἐσχάραι πυρός
KJV	Out of his mouth go burning lamps, and sparks of fire leap out.

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
