ESV	He counts iron as straw, and bronze as rotten wood.
NIV	Iron he treats like straw and bronze like rotten wood.
NLT	Iron is nothing but straw to that creature, and bronze is like rotten wood.
LXX	ἡγῆται μὲν γὰρ σίδηρον ἄχυρα χαλκὸν δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ὥσπερ ξύλον σαθρόν
KJV	He esteemeth iron as straw, and brass as rotten wood.

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
