Hebrew	
ESV	Clubs are counted as stubble; he laughs at the rattle of javelins.
NIV	A club seems to him but a piece of straw; he laughs at the rattling of the lance.
NLT	Clubs are like a blade of grass, and it laughs at the swish of javelins.
LXX	ὥς καλάμη ἐλογίσθησαν σφῦραι καταγεῶν δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. σειμοῦ πυρφόρου
KJV	Darts are counted as stubble: he laugheth at the shaking of a spear.
