ESV	Behind him he leaves a shining wake; one would think the deep to be white-haired.
NIV	Behind him he leaves a glistening wake; one would think the deep had white hair.
NLT	The water glistens in its wake, making the sea look white.
LXX	τὸν greek The definite article δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. τάρταρον τῆς greek The definite article ἀβύσσου ὥπερ αἰχμάλωτον ἐλογίσατο ἄβυσσον εἰς περίπατον
KJV	He maketh a path to shine after him; one would think the deep to be hoary.

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
