ESV	They meet with darkness in the daytime and grope at noonday as in the night.
NIV	Darkness comes upon them in the daytime; at noon they grope as in the night.
NLT	They find it is dark in the daytime, and they grope at noon as if it were night.

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. μεσημβρινὸν ψηλαφήσασαν ἴσα νυκτί
