ESV	You would even cast lots over the fatherless, and bargain over your friend.
NIV	You would even cast lots for the fatherless and barter away your friend.
NLT	You would even send an orphan into slavery or sell a friend.
LXX	πλὴν ὅτι ἐπ' ὀρφανῶ ἐπιπίπτετε ἐνάλλεσθε δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐπὶ φίλῳ ὑμῶν
KJV	Yea, ye overwhelm the fatherless, and ye dig a pit for your friend.

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
