Hebrew	Meanings by Stem Qal Stem (basic form) To be firm, stable, fixed, established. Describes something that stands securely or endures. Psalm 93:2 Psalm 103:19 Proverbs 16:9 Psalm 96:102 Samuel 7:16 Proverbs 16:3 Luke 22:321 Peter 5:101 Corinthians 1:8 Hebrews 2:3 Colossians 1:23 Matthew 25:34
ESV	"For inquire, please, of bygone ages, and consider what the fathers have searched out.
NIV	"Ask the former generations and find out what their fathers learned,
NLT	"Just ask the previous generation. Pay attention to the experience of our ancestors.
LXX	ἐπερώτησον γὰρ γενεὰν πρώτην ἐξιχνίασον δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English.
