Hebrew	חָכֵם לִבָּב וְאַמִּיץ כֹּחַ מִי הִקְשָׁה אֵלָיו וַיִּשְׁלָם
ESV	He is wise in heart and mighty in strength- who has hardened himself against him, and succeeded?-
NIV	His wisdom is profound, his power is vast. Who has resisted him and come out unscathed?
NLT	For God is so wise and so mighty. Who has ever challenged him successfully?
LXX	σοφὸς γὰρ ἐστὶν εἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. διανοίᾳ κραταίός τε καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” μέγας τίς σκληρὸς γενόμενος ἐναντίον αὐτοῦ αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὑπέμεινεν
KJV	He is wise in heart, and mighty in strength: who hath hardened himself against him, and hath prospered?

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
