Hebrew	הַיְהוָה לַיּוֹם כָּרוֹב יוֹם הַיְהוָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word הַיְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. 	NLT The day of the LORD is near, the day when destruction comes from the Almighty. How terrible that day will be!
