	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. εἰς τὸνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

The definite article πατρός, ἐκεῖνος ἐξηγήσατο.	
ESV	No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.

NLT	No one has ever seen God. But the one and only Son is himself God and is near to the Father's heart. He has revealed God to us.
