Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. IT is most frequently translated as “and” λέγει περὶ αὐτοῦ αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἔδε ἀληθῶς Ἰσραηλείτης, ἐν ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ὃ δόλος οὐκ ἔστιν εἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
