Meaning

* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)

Ναθαναήλ· ῥαββεί, σὺ εἶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

The definite article υἱὸς τοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

The definite article θεοῦ, plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς

Masculine noun meaning:

* A god or goddess * God σὺ βασιλεὺς εἶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί

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The definite article Ἰσραήλ.

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
