Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 μειζόν ἐστιν
Greek	greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” οὐδεὶς δύναται ἄρπάξαι ἐκ τῆς greek The definite article χειρὸς τοῦ greek The definite article πατρός.
ESV	My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand.

NIV	My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.
NLT	for my Father has given them to me, and he is more powerful than anyone else. No one can snatch them from the Father's hand.
KJV	My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

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
