Then Thomas (called Didymus) said to the rest of the disciples, "Let us also go, that we may NIV die with him." **NLT** Thomas, nicknamed the Twin, said to his fellow disciples, "Let's go, too- and die with Jesus." Then said Thomas, which is called Didymus, unto his fellowdisciples, Let us also go, that we KIV may die with him.
