It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἤγειρεν ἐκ νεκρῶν Ἰησοῦς. Six days before the Passover, Jesus therefore came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, whom **ESV** Jesus had raised from the dead.
