For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. I am telling you this now, before it takes place, that when it does take place you may believe **ESV** that I am he. "I am telling you now before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe that I am NIV He. NLT I tell you this beforehand, so that when it happens you will believe that I Am the Messiah. KJV Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I am he.
