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ESV	When he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in him.
NIV	When he was gone, Jesus said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified and God is glorified in him.
NLT	As soon as Judas left the room, Jesus said, "The time has come for the Son of Man to enter into his glory, and God will be glorified because of him.
KJV	Therefore, when he was gone out, Jesus said, Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him.

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
