Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" εἶπεν αὐτῷ·plugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigαὐτός

Meaning

\* He, she, it \* Himself, herself, itself \* Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Meaning:

\* Who \* Which \* What

The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).

It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἐγὼ ποιῶplugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigποιέω

Meaning:

\* To do \* To make

This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.

Verb forms

Present tense Person Greek Form σὺ οὐκ οἶδας ἄρτι, γνώση δὲplugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigδέ

δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. μετὰ ταῦτα.plugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigoὖτος / αὕτη /τοῦτο

greek

Meaning:

\* These or this \* This one, this person, this thing \* They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὖτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19

ESV	Jesus answered him, "What I am doing you do not understand now, but afterward you will understand."
NIV	Jesus replied, "You do not realize now what I am doing, but later you will understand."
NLT	Jesus replied, "You don't understand now what I am doing, but someday you will."
KJV	Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but thou shalt know hereafter.
