Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big καί

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" οὐ χρεῖαν ἔχεις ἵνα τίς σε ἐρωτῇ· ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ἐν

Preposition meaning "in". τούτῳ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο

Meaning:

* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:16 1 John 5:11 1 Corinthians 15:50 1 John 4:9 John 5:1 Matthew 3:17 John 7:26 Luke 22:19 πιστεύομεν ὅτι ἀπὸ θεοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big θεὸς
