Before the New Testament, λ óγος already had deep philosophical use. In Greek philosophy, λ óγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things. εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example $\epsilon l\mu i$ is the word for am and $\tilde{\eta} v$ is the word for was, e.g.

ESV	Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.
NIV	Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.
NLT	Make them holy by your truth; teach them your word, which is truth.
KJV	Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.
