Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. 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ESV	For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed.
NIV	Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that his deeds will be exposed.
NLT	All who do evil hate the light and refuse to go near it for fear their sins will be exposed.
KJV	For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reprov'd.

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
