Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. At its core, it usually describes movement or relationship toward someone or something, whether physical, s... αὐτόν·

	ἐὰν μὴ σημεῖα καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” τέρατα ἴδῃτε, οὐ μὴ πιστεύσητε.
	ESV So Jesus said to him, “Unless you see signs and wonders you will not believe.”
	NIV “Unless you people see miraculous signs and wonders,” Jesus told him, “you will never believe.”
NLT	Jesus asked, “Will you never believe in me unless you see miraculous signs and wonders?”
KJV	Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.
