Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. παρ’ ἐμοῦ πέν αἰτεῖς γυναῖκός Σαμαρίτιδος οὔσης; plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί

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
