This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.

Verb forms

greek

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example $\epsilon l \mu l$ is the word for am and $\hbar v$ is the word for was, e.g.

- ESV And he has given him authority to execute judgment, because he is the Son of Man.
- NIV And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man.
- NLT And he has given him authority to judge everyone because he is the Son of Man.
- KJV And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.
