	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἀληθής·

NIV	"If I testify about myself, my testimony is not valid.
NLT	"If I were to testify on my own behalf, my testimony would not be valid.
KJV	If I bear witness of myself, my witness is not true.
