Greek	λόγος in Greek Thought
	Before the New Testament, λόγος already had deep philosophical use. In Greek philosophy, λόγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things. 	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

	Meaning:
	* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it
	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ὁμεῖς οὐ πιστεύετε .

ESV	and you do not have his word abiding in you, for you do not believe the one whom he has sent.
NIV	nor does his word dwell in you, for you do not believe the one he sent.
NLT	and you do not have his message in your hearts, because you do not believe me- the one he sent to you.
KJV	And ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not.

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
