Greek	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" περιπάτει.

	NLT	Jesus told him, "Stand up, pick up your mat, and walk!"
	KJV	Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.

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
