	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

	Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 ἔδωκεν αὐτοῖςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός

	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
	Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) φαγεῖν.

ESV	Our fathers ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written, 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.' "
NIV	Our forefathers ate the manna in the desert; as it is written: 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.' "
NLT	After all, our ancestors ate manna while they journeyed through the wilderness! The Scriptures say, 'Moses gave them bread from heaven to eat.' "
KJV	Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat.

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
