It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. Jesus answered them, "Did I not choose you, the Twelve? And yet one of you is a devil." **ESV** NIV Then Jesus replied, "Have I not chosen you, the Twelve? Yet one of you is a devil!" **NLT** Then Jesus said, "I chose the twelve of you, but one is a devil." KIV lesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
