It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ὅτι τὴνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article ἀλήθειαν λέγω, οὐ πιστεύετε μοι.
