Greek	greek The definite article τὴν Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1
ESV	And once more he bent down and wrote on the ground.
NIV	Again he stooped down and wrote on the ground.
NLT	Then he stooped down again and wrote in the dust.
KJV	And again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground.
