	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. καὶ

	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and”

Greek	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

	This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.

	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἀκούει.

ESV	We know that God does not listen to sinners, but if anyone is a worshiper of God and does his will, God listens to him.
NIV	We know that God does not listen to sinners. He listens to the godly man who does his will.
NLT	We know that God doesn't listen to sinners, but he is ready to hear those who worship him and do his will.
KJV	Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.

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
