Greek	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” τίς ἐστίν,

	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. κύριε, ἵνα πιστεύσω εἰς αὐτόν;

	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
	Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
ESV	He answered, “And who is he, sir, that I may believe in him?”
NIV	“Who is he, sir?” the man asked. “Tell me so that I may believe in him.”
NLT	The man answered, “Who is he, sir? I want to believe in him.”
KJV	He answered and said, Who is he, Lord, that I might believe on him?

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
