		Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” προσεκύνησεν αὐτῷ.

		Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

ESV	He said, “Lord, I believe,” and he worshiped him.	
NIV	Then the man said, “Lord, I believe,” and he worshiped him.	
NLT	“Yes, Lord, I believe!” the man said. And he worshiped Jesus.	
KJV	And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.	

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
