Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 εἰπὼν ἔπτυσεν χαμαὶ καὶplugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip\_big

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and”
