Usage in the New Testament

The sense of **πᾶς** depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 **γένους** **Ἰσραὴλ** **καὶ** **πάντες**
