Hebrew The word בָּרַךְ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope.Genesis 1:28Psalm 103:1Numbers 6:24 את הוֹשַׁע וִיתָן את את hebrew The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (חָבְרוּ לְכָל־בֶּן יִפְגַּח לְנַחֲלָה
ESV	Then Joshua blessed him, and he gave Hebron to Caleb the son of Jephunneh for an inheritance.
NIV	Then Joshua blessed Caleb son of Jephunneh and gave him Hebron as his inheritance.
NLT	So Joshua blessed Caleb son of Jephunneh and gave Hebron to him as his portion of land.
