Preposition that relates to movement through space, time, means or cause - it's a preposition of movement and mediation.

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:16 1 John 5:11 1 Corinthians 15:50 1 John 4:9 John 5:1 Matthew 3:17 John 7:26 Luke 22:19 ἐγενήθη ἡ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big
